What should I do if I don't see these things?

- 1. When in doubt ask the vendor if they have proof of being permitted and inspected in the county.
- 2. If the vendor cannot provide proof, we advise you to not purchase or consume the food product being sold as they are not inspected by your local health department and could be a potential risk to your health.
